



REQUEST FOR RESEARCH ASSISTANCE

As part of an ongoing research project at the University of Adelaide, we are currently seeking the assistance of work health and safety practitioners and professionals across all industries.

The aim of this research project is to develop a brief, cross-industry measure for work safety climate. As a leading indicator, work safety climate can be used to predict future safety performance, including work-stress related claims and accidents.

To ensure that the most safety relevant items are selected for the brief measure, we are seeking the assistance of work health and safety practitioners and professionals. Participants will be asked to look at a selection of questions, and rank them from those they believe are most important, to those they believe are least important when it comes to measuring work safety climate within their type of organisation. This will also assist in ensuring the brief measure contains questions relevant across a range of industry-types.

The ranking process should take approximately 15-20 minutes and can be performed at the participant's own computer. Results will be aggregated and confidential, and only the industry sector you represent will be recorded.
