





Workshop title: A practical approach to improve investigations and identify systemic organisational issues

About the workshop:

Nearly every organisation undertakes some form of incident investigation and most are struggling with delivering meaningful outcomes. This practical workshop will discuss that changing both “Why” and “How” we investigate can result in the discovery of systemic issues which allows organisations to achieve real risk reduction.

The workshop will learn how the importance of understanding how the systems and conditions of the work contribute to both the work’s success and failure. Participants will be shown an easy, practical investigation model, based on modern safety concepts, designed to discover the systemic risk which underlies the work. A generative questioning exercise will demonstrate how effective storytelling can be in developing an understanding of everyday work.
